## Monday 12 April

### Bay of Plenty to Havelock North

### Napier Art Deco

**10.30am** We depart for Napier. Today choose between a HISTORIC HERITAGE WALKING tour or relive the glamour and style of the jazz era with a unique experience of a LUXURIOUS VINTAGE CAR tour. The original town of Napier was levelled by a dramatic and devastating earthquake in 1931 but was completely rebuilt within a remarkable two year period in the contemporary style of the times; Art Deco. The city is now recognised as the most complete Art Deco city in the world.

At 12.30pm we then drive over to AHURIRI for lunch (at own cost) at one of the many cafes or beachside restaurants and maybe take a walk along the boardwalk or indulge in some retail therapy.

We then return to Napier to explore the MTG Hawke's BAY, home of the region's taonga and other treasures. The museum also showcases changing exhibitions of art, culture and social history. Afternoon tea at the MASONIC HOTEL will be our finishing point in Napier this afternoon.
